About the Swap

The West Seattle Bike Swap benefits the Cascade Education Major Taylor Project. Ninety percent of revenue from the Swap will go to the Major Taylor Project. 100% off all bikes and equipment donated will go directly to the Major Taylor Project.

About the Major Taylor Project

The Major Taylor Project is a collaborative grass roots effort, to create a multicultural cycling community in King County. Cascade Bicycle Club Education Foundation, is dedicated to creating an environment where all King County teenagers have equal opportunity to enjoy the outdoors and benefits of cycling. Teens will explore mountain biking, road riding, and track riding, as well as bicycle safety, skills, mechanics, environmental and socioeconomic issues, and map making. In return for contributing to the club and to their communities and working to achieve their own goals, club participants will have access to skilled training in different kinds of bicycling and a supportive community of adults who will help them achieve their goals. The project is named for Marshall "Major" Taylor, the first African American professional cyclist. Born in 1878, Major Taylor's professional racing career spanned 13 years and included several world championships and world records.

How the Swap works.

There are three ways to sell or donate your bikes and bike equipment.

A. Consignment. You can drop off your bike at the West Seattle Cycle University location, April 20th - May 1. You establish a price you would like to get for the bike. We then tag the bike with the price and have it available on May 2 for the swap. If the bike sells then we will have the money available for you to pick up the following week. There will be a 15% consignment fee deducted from all bikes sold. Bikes will be sold on an as is basis with no warranty available or returns accepted.

If your bike does not sell then you can pick it up the next week or you can have the bike donated to the Major Taylor Project.

B. Rent a Space. If you have a lot of bikes or bike equipment to sell then you can rent a space, 5ftx5ft or 10x10ft. Costs are \$10 for a 5x5 and \$20 for a 10x10ft space. You can sell bike or bike related equipment. Cycle University reserves the right to not allow items be sold if they are determined to be either dangerous or not in keeping with the guidelines outlined in the rental agreement.

C. Donate. Any bike or bike related equipment can be donated to the Major Taylor Project. All donations are tax deductible.
